The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2015

Made 11 February 2016


Coming into force 21 March 2016

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A(2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order -

1. This Order may be cited as 'The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2015' and shall come into effect on 21 March 2016
2. The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme set out in the Schedule to this Order complies with all aspects of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, with all other primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes, and does not exceed the powers provided under such legislation.
3. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme.
4. The "Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme" means the permit scheme commonly known as "The West and Shires Permit Scheme" which is a 'common', or regional scheme already in use in the West Midlands region.
5. The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme comes into effect on 21 March 2016
6. 'Specified streets' has the meaning given by regulation 8 Traffic Management Permit Schemes (England) Regulations 2007
